4. Travelling and Accommodation

Travelling to Bremen

... by plane:

Bremen Airport can be reached by national and international flights. The airport is in close distance to the city and the university. It is a ride of 10 – 15 min by taxi or tramway (Line 6 direction Centrum / Universität).

... by train:

Bremen main station is located very close to the city centre. The station has a good hourly connection to the high-speed long-distance railway network (ICE trains) and can be reached from Hamburg or Hannover in about one hour, from Frankfurt or Düsseldorf in three hours.

... by car:

The highways A1 is connecting Bremen with Hamburg (~ 1h) and Western Germany. From the south the A7 / A27 is the direct connection from Frankfurt (~ 4h) via Hannover (~ 1h) to Bremen respectively A2/A7/A27 from Berlin via Hannover. From the Netherlands, the NL A7 and A28 (via Groningen and Oldenburg) or NL A1 and A30/A1 via Oldenzaal / Osnabrück can be used.

Parking lots at the university are restricted this year due to construction works, for details contact us by e-mail.

... by ship:

In case you prefer to sail to Bremen you can reach the most southerly seaport of Germany via the Weser river. From the pilot boarding ground 75nm, from Bremerhaven 40nm.

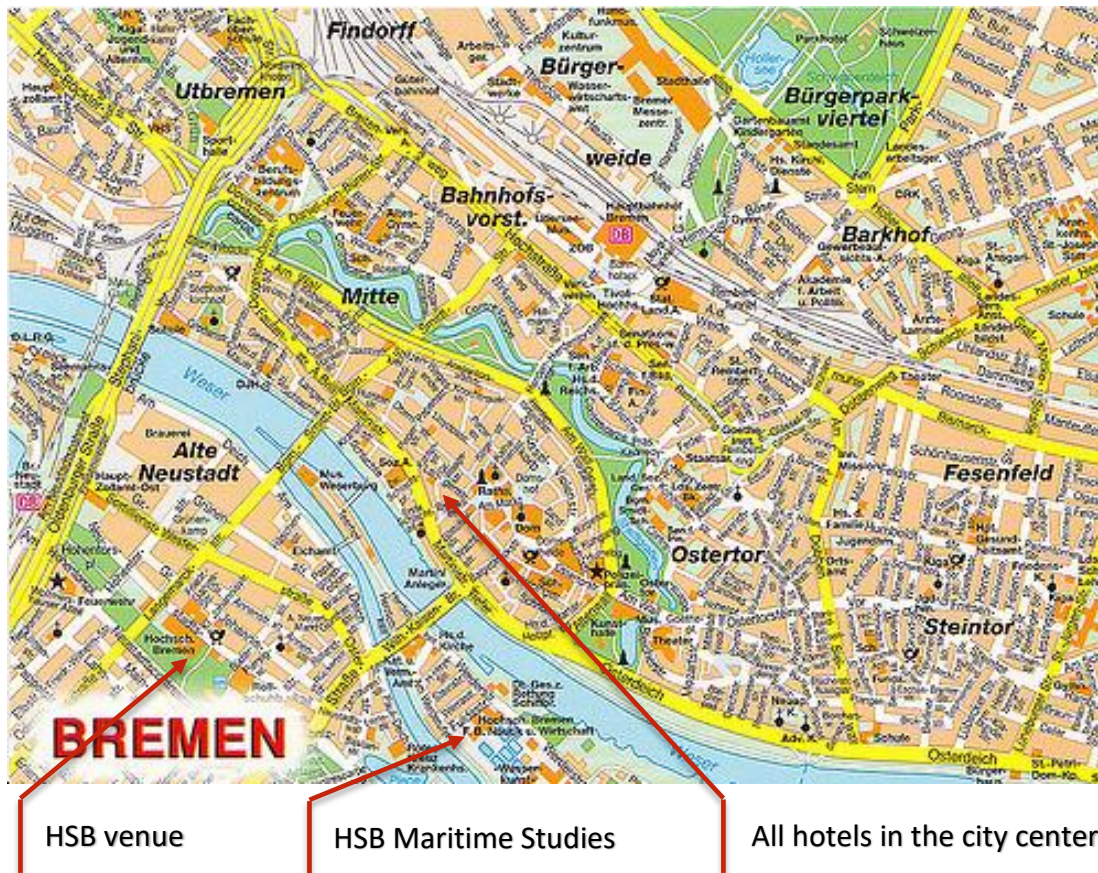
