## Second announcement / Final call for papers

The MARSIM 2018 Conference marks the 40 year anniversary of this event. In 1978 the first conference was organized by the IMSF founding fathers and held at Warsash in Southampton, UK. Ever since, the conference has been held with 3 year intervals in sequence with the AGM in the years in between.

The 2018 conference will cover four days and include the Annual General Meeting, paper presentations, simulation exhibits and an optional technical tour and visit. A registration reception, casual and conference dinner, lunches and coffee/tea breaks are included in the conference fee. The preliminary programme is included in this announcement.

IMSF members who have not fulfilled their contribution dues are requested to settle this in advance or then and there. All participants shall cover their own travel, accommodation and incidental expenses.

As Halifax can be considered very popular in the summer months, we strongly advise all participants to book travel and accommodation as soon as possible. Information of the preferred accommodation facility is also mentioned.

We kindly request you to **register before 31 May 2018** to facilitate planning of catering and facilities. This is possible by internet/email by means of the included registration form. ## **PAPERS**

Although MARSIM conferences started mainly discussing simulation with ship bridge systems, we feel that inclusion of simulation of the entire marine domain is urgently required to justify the mere existence of the International Marine Simulator Forum.

Therefore it is explicitly requested to widen the range topics presented, to include all types of present and future marine simulation, in the widest sense.

Suggested paper topics could thus include, but are not limited to:

- a. Trends in computer simulation technology,
- b. Hydrodynamic, visual and other related (mathematical) modelling,
- c. Applications of simulation in navigation, engineering, communication, survival, offshore, dredging, pollution control, autonomous shipping,
- d. Simulation applied in education, training, and research,
- e. Instructors, assessors, supervisors in the simulation loop,
- f. Relevant other simulation applications in the entire marine domain.

All selected paper presentations will be scheduled as a 30 min. session. Depending on the types and amount of topics there will be up to 3 simultaneous streams of presentations.

A printed version of the introduction of each paper will be available at the conference opening. The complete version of the papers will be distributed by USB stick.

A detailed schedule for selected workshop sessions will be announced in advance of the AGM.

**They have blocked sufficient rooms with attractive rate for our expected attendees until appr.mid June. You are thus strongly urged to try and make you hotel bookings soonest.**

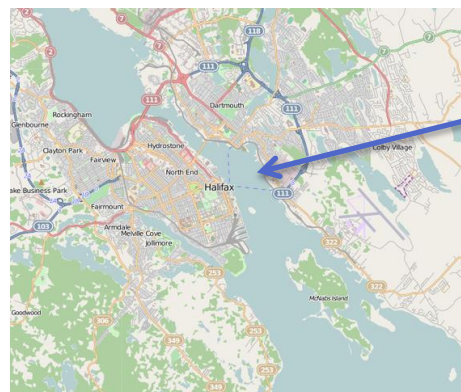
The hotel booking and payment should be direct to the hotel of which details are below.
